GRANTS

1. VW EVSE (\$6 million) DEEP Award

- Awarded 319 Level 2 (540 plugs) and 26 DCFC (40 plugs)
- Challenges include contracts, rising costs, utility readiness
- 10+ projects completed

2. Charging and Fueling Infrastructure (\$14 million) from U.S. DOT

- Community Grants to 7 CT municipalities, 96 DCFC, 8 Level 2 EVSE (16 Ports)
- DEEP Release an RFP for a program administrator on March 31. Due April 30

3. CPRG Clean Corridor Grant

- \$209 million award to four states (NJ, MD, DE, and CT). CT share is ~\$54 million
- Development of three to six MHD EV Charging locations on major transportation corridors
- Could include Megawatt Charging units
- NJ has closed its RFP to hire a central administrator and is evaluating proposals

CLEAN SCHOOL BUS JOINT FUNDING PROGRAM

5. EPA Clean School Bus Grants, Supplemental Funding, and Connecticut Green Bank

- In February 2025, DEEP and CGB launched a joint program to solicit applications for joint supplemental funding and low interest financing to cover uncovered costs or projects funded by EPA
- 5 Awards were given out by DEEP to cover up to \$5.2 million in uncovered costs
- DEEP is still working with projects to solve additional issues, funding gaps, etc.
- Three projects are working with CGB for additional funding
- EPA funding can be drawn down for Round 1 and 2 projects. Round 3 still in limbo.
