EV Charging Pilot Program

We've been working together with Voltpost and Clean Transportation – Western CT to assist Voltpost in their mission to democratize charging access by deploying convenient and affordable charging across all communities. They'll do this by retrofitting lampposts into the Voltpost modular and upgradable charging platform powered by a mobile app. Through the generous support of Connecticut Public Utilities Regulatory Authority (PURA) and the Connecticut Innovative Energy Solutions (IES), Voltpost aims to deploy 40-60 dual-port charging stations, for a total of 80-120 charging ports, at zero cost to the municipalities across Eversource and United Illuminating (UI) territory in Connecticut.

Key Highlights

Deployment Scope: 50 stations, 100 ports, set for completion by Q4 2026.

Partners Involved: Collaborates with Eversource, United Illuminating (UI), Capitol Clean Cities, and Live Green Connecticut.

Community Focus: 20% of chargers target disadvantaged areas, reducing **200 metric tons of carbon yearly**.

Job Creation: Local, W/MBE-certified businesses will handle installations.

Highschool Technical Propane AutoGas Training

We partnered with the Propane Education Research Council (PERC) and Cusson Automotive (local propane upfitter and service provider) to provide the 1st in New England Technical Training at Vinal Technical Highschool in Middletown. We provided a 4-hour classroom propane Autogas training for 25 students who showed sincere interest in learning about propane Autogas and all alternative fuels instead of just diesel and gasoline which is the school's current mainstream. We explained that it is important for them to look ahead to the future and learn about alternative fuels, service and maintenance. We have another training scheduled for September where the students will be working side by side to retrofit one of the school's vehicles to run on propane Autogas. We hope to expand our training to include our technical schools throughout CT.


